The admission criteria is

- Australian level 7 bachelor's qualification or recognised equivalent
- GPA of 2.70 (out of 4.00) For international students: IELTS of 6.5 overall with minimum 6.0 in each band, or equivalent.

Program Duration

The program consists of 80 credit points which students can complete in 1.5 - 2.5 years of full-time study, depending on RPL granted. If you have an accounting-related undergraduate degree, you may be exempt from the gateway component (600-level units)
